

BOARD PROCEDURE

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT: Date: August 7, 2000

The following procedures are established for determining hazardous area bus service:

1. Students in kindergarten through grade five only are eligible for courtesy service.
2. Special courtesy bus routes for high hazard areas will become operational as soon as an area is established as being a high hazard risk for students.
3. The determination of what constitutes a high hazard area will be made by a special committee consisting of a representative when needed, from the following:
 - a. Georgia State Highway Patrol
 - b. Georgia Department of Transportation
 - c. Columbia County Sheriff's Department
 - d. Columbia County Engineering Department
 - e. Director of School Transportation, Columbia County Schools, Chairman.
4. The operation of these special routes in terms of numbers of stops and the placement of stops will be determined by the safety committee and the Director of Transportation.
5. Special bus routes for high hazard areas will be eliminated when the hazardous conditions cease to exist, or when other safety measures have been taken to reduce the hazard.
