FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

Date: June 22, 1999

1. Parents will be notified in writing and/or by phone from the school when their child or children have charged five (5) meals, including breakfast. Parents are expected to make immediate payment on the account to assure a positive balance so the child may continue to participate in the school meal program.
2. Parents will be notified in writing and/or by phone from the school when their child or children have charged 10 meals, including breakfast. The child will be denied meal privileges until the account is paid in full and a balance is established to allow the child to purchase meals.
3. Failure of parents to provide a meal or money for a meal can result in referral to The Department of Family and Children's Services for neglect of parental responsibility.
4. High school students and adults are not permitted to charge meals.
