**EMPLOYEE EXTENDED
DAY/YEAR SALARIES**

Date: October 5, 2009

Teachers **may** earn extended day status by meeting **identified** criteria **in one of the following two areas:**

Career, Technical and Agriculture Education (CTAE) State-Based Extended Day:

A Program-of-Work is required to be submitted to the State Department of Education to qualify for State-Based Extended Day. State-Based Extended Day in Columbia County is based on a six-period day with an unencumbered planning period and is requested for those CTAE teachers who agree to adhere to and fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Career Technology Student Organization (CTSO) participation**
- 2. Career-related education activities including the supervision of work-based learning students. Cooperative Education student participation is limited to 28 students per supervisory period allocated to the teacher, with a maximum of 56 total students per State Board Rule 160-5-1-.08.**

Contingent upon state funding, state-based extended day pay will be awarded annually and calculated based on the funds available divided by the number of teachers who request it at each level.

General Education 9-12 (Non-CTAE) Extended Day:

For general education courses, teachers will earn extended day, adding 1/8 of the daily earned salary, provided their schedule requires a six-period day with no embedded planning. A minimum of 138 students in 6 segments is required before a teacher qualifies for extended day salary per State Board Rule 160-5-1.08, Code: IEC.

Department chairpersons will be utilized on extended day as a last resort.
