FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

Date: August 10, 1999

The principal will recommend school food service workers for employment in writing to the Superintendent of Schools. The Superintendent then recommends the workers to the Board of Education for approval.

Hairnets must be used by all employees of the lunchroom. Aprons and uniforms are highly recommended.

Cost of school lunches shall be in keeping with the Board of Education's rulings.

Every child shall have access to services of the school lunchroom.

The manager of the school cafeteria is responsible to the Director of School Nutrition for lunchroom forms being completed, corrected and submitted on time.

All personnel must attend 6 hours of in-service training during the school year.

Elementary and middle schools will participate in the offer versus serve provision of the National School Lunch Program.
