STUDENTS RELEASE  
TO NON-CUSTODIAL PARENTS

Date: MARCH 14, 2006

---

School officials shall not release students to individuals other than custodial parents or guardians. However, with written permission or at the verbal request of the custodial parent or guardian during emergency situations, the principal may release a student to a designated individual.

When a request to release a student from school is made, school officials shall verify the authenticity of the dismissal request before releasing the student. If the identity of the individual picking up the student is not known, school officials should seek proper identification or consult with the custodial parent or guardian before releasing the student.
